

Dream Ladder

Purchase medium and small sized dowels from a craft store. Prior to class, cut the medium sized dowels into 8 inch lengths. Drill five evenly spaced holes sized to fit the small dowels in a straight line on each of the medium sized dowels. These will be the legs of the ladders. Cut the small dowels into 2 inch lengths. Divide the dowels into one ladder per package:

2 – 8 inch pre-drilled dowels

5 – 2 inch dowels

2 – 4 inch blocks

1 small wood glue

Stickers with FEAR, DOUBT, UN-COMMITTED, OBSTACLES, JEALOUSY, ROD, STAFF, and GOD’S DREAM for ME printed on them.

Give one package to each student and have them assemble with glue the “Dream Ladder”. Place stickers on the “steps” to indicate what must be overcome. Place ROD on one leg and STAFF on the other leg of the ladder to indicate the presence of God to help them overcome each problem. Students should then write their initial on the bottom rung of the ladder and place the “God’s Dream for Me” sticker on the top rung. The ladder should look as follows when finished:
