

Craft: “Peg Game”

Purchase a 1”x4”x6’ pine or fir board from a local home improvement store. Use a miter saw box and alternately cut a 45 degree slice, then flip board and cut another 45 degree slice. This should leave a triangle piece of board for the game. Drill the 15 holes in the game board and place golf tees in each as shown in Figure 1 below. Print the “No Distractions” labels for the back of the board using the print sheet in Appendix 8 Craft. Provide pieces of fine sand paper and permanent markers.

Have the members lightly sand the game board, and write their initials on one side using the colored permanent markers. Have members place a label on the back of the game board. Pass out the golf tees and small containers of Elmer’s Wood Glue. Put a little glue in each peg hole and then put the tees in the holes. That’s right! You just made the game unusable and not a distraction. Tell members this board is a reminder to them not to become distracted and to keep focused on God’s Dream.
