In Search of the Holy Grail

This recreation activity is designed with three objectives in mind:

- 1) Work together as a team to solve a problem
- 2) See the passion that Paul needed to have in order to make the missionary journeys he made.
- 3) Learn the geography of the eastern Mediterranean Sea.

Print the maps of Paul's journeys provided in Appendix 7 Other Resources. Divide the tribe into teams of three or more. Print the clues provided for this activity located in Appendix 6 Recreation. Select locations throughout the building or outdoors in a manner to match (roughly) the geographic directions of the journeys. See Holy Grail Map Example in Appendix 6 Recreation. Place a clue at each city location to assist a team in finding the next location. Start each team at a different city in the journey. Begin the journey with the clue for the next city provided at that location. At the end of the journey, place a price to reward the team's journey.
