

A Note from the Author

Having spent most of my career developing and implementing corporate change, the "opportunity" to teach this age group during our church's Wednesday night program, was an even greater challenge. For adults, youth can be extremely frustrating. They can seem "wild" at times and genius at other times. The reality, however, is that this time in their lives will greatly determine the path they will follow. Sadly, many will turn to the destructive forces in the world seeking fun, wealth, and power. This book, hopefully, will help keep them from taking the dark path of the world.

I call this a behavior "intervention" series. An intervention as I use it here is an attempt to make a change in behavior at a specific time in a person's life. Youth are beginning to make the choices that will determine their path in life. God has a plan for each life, a plan which in this series is "God's Dream". My hope is that each young person that reads this series will find that Dream.

"Change" is a popular concept now. But knowing what we are changing to is as important as changing. Middle School students are changing rapidly: physically, mentally, and emotionally. What they are changing to is often determined by peers, television, movies, family, and sports.

To those young people who read this series of life changing stories, let me write a few words. You are now at a time in your life that can lead down many paths. Some paths will lead to the dark side of life, for some, even suicide. For others, the path chosen will lead away from family and your home town to travel the world or to give your life work in service to others. Some of you may take a lifetime to find the Dream of God for your life, while others may find it quickly.

When you find the Dream, the joy of the relationship with God in that Dream will be like a cup overflowing with love. For me it took most of my life to realize that Dream. Hopefully you will find your Dream early in life. Listen to your heart and learn the wisdom to choose the correct path in life. You are given many examples in history to help you gain wisdom. You will not be alone in the search for your Dream: God wants you to find it and provides guideposts for you.


The "Notepad" developed is designed to be a "road map" for your life. Follow it with commitment and all of your heart. God will be there to help you.

A Note from the Author

I hope you have enjoyed the series so far, but more importantly that you believe that God did have you in his mind long before you were born and that he has a Dream specifically for you.

"Fear of the LORD is the beginning of Wisdom." But it is only the "beginning". In this the third book in the "Dudley's Cave and the Circle of Fire" series, the "I AM TRIBE" will need to apply the wisdom they have gained. The "Notepad" of Key Learning's recorded during their journey will be helpful on the quest to obey the command of a gentle voice to "Find Elijah" and the way home. The Notepad is provided at the end of this book for reference.

The Tribe learned in the "Journey to Light" that for the successes in their lives they are to give praise to the Lord, and thanks to others. For failures, they learned that being accountable is critical if God's Dream is to be achieved.

"In Search of Elijah" provides an example of a man seeking the Dream of God. You will follow Elijah as he uses the opportunities given to him by Yahweh to achieve the Dream after failure and a second chance. As a bonus, you will be taught the map of Israel and Judah just prior to Israel being taken into captivity by Assyria.

Elijah went from the mountain top of success on Mount Carmel to the valley of despair in the cave. He thought he could do anything, yet had failed to convert the people back to Yahweh. But God did not leave him. He waited patiently outside the cave for Elijah to lift up his head and "look up" for Him. In the third adventure book, "In Search of Elijah", the "I AM Tribe" will experience looking up to God as the Circle of Fire seeks to find the prophet and the way home.





A Note from the Author

This is the fourth book in the series "Dudley's Cave and the Circle of Fire." In this book the Tribe begins a series of travels to find the secret of the jewels of Yahweh. The jewels were placed on a Breastpiece worn by the High Priest of Israel as instructed by Yahweh. Dudley had pulled the Breastpiece from the High Priest in a struggle to free Paul from jail. In so doing, the jewels fell from the Breastpiece and disappeared. The Tribe must find each jewel and its special meaning to Yahweh and to the Dream of God for each of them. In Ephesians 6:14, the Apostle Paul implores his readers to "stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place." The I AM Tribe members are given the "belt" or sash of truth as they begin their quest for the meaning of the "breastplate of righteousness" in both the Old and New Testaments.

Each of us struggles with doing "right" things. Darkness and Light struggle inside use for control, like the ying yang ball. From the time sin entered into the world until the Lord returns, the battle will continue for our hearts, minds, and souls. In this book the students will see both sides and learn the how to defeat the darkness within.

In the beginning of this series I stressed to the Tribe the importance of their lives to God, and that I AM loved the "I am" that was his Dream for each of them personally. The name they were given by their parents is not the name God gave them. In this book, the Tribe will learn the names and meanings of the twelve sons of Judah. 

A Note from the Author

Thirteen men reclined around a large table in the upper room of a house in Jerusalem that night. It was a very somber setting. All knew that the Master who sat in the center position had returned to the city expecting to be killed by the people. The twelve men didn't want Jesus to go to the Passover event. The High Priest and the Pharisees were bent on finding a way to kill him.

Still Jesus went to Jerusalem and entered riding on a donkey to the cheers of thousands of people. This was no way for a new king to take his rightful position. Why did he do this? The people embraced him. Maybe it would turn out alright after all, some of the men at the table had thought. Then Jesus went into the Temple. He turned over the tables of merchants selling offerings to the people and claimed that if the Temple were torn down, he would rebuild it in just three days! The ruling Sanhedrin, led by the High Priest, had turned the cheering crowd against the Master. The only way to avoid arrest was to seek asylum in another country. The three year ministry was at an end: or was it?

The Master sat up; lifted a loaf of bread from the table; blessed it, and said, "Take and eat; this is my body." The ritual of hospitality was familiar to the men; but why did Jesus need to use it. They had followed him for three years. Didn't he know they were bound to him as friends?

Who were these twelve men chosen by the Master to be his closest students? Surely he could have found better choices than these men. One even worked for the hated Romans collecting tribute taxes for them. Two others had close ties with the rebellion forces against Rome. Others were just common fishermen; not leaders of the country. How could Jesus hope to restore the kingdom with these men?

The men ate the hospitality bread in silent thought. They had never seen the Master so defeated. Why didn't Jesus just call down his angels and take the throne, two of them thought, the rebels in the group. Others were confused; hadn't they asked to be on each side of the Master in the new kingdom? What would happen after the Master died? One left the table disappointed and walked into the darkness outside.

It was time for the Silver Cup to be used. The house servant went to the place where the owner kept it hidden from the Romans. He opened the box and was stunned: the Silver Cup was missing. The ritual that would bind these men to the Lord until death could not be performed. The servant ran from the house and to the "I AM Tribe". It was time for another journey!

As you seek to find the Dream of God for your life, one thing is certain: you must drink from the Silver Cup as the disciples did that night. They didn't understand it; but they would find the Dream of God for each of them; and so will you. Record your thoughts for each lesson in this journal.
